Program Report - Children/Youth Project February 1 - June 30, 1988

The Children/Youth Project has conducted approximately seventy (70) workshops to an estimated two thousand five hundred (2,500) young people in face to face workshops around the Philadelphia area. These workshops have been conducted by the project manager and a small volunteer staff.

The Project Manager has presented BEBASHI's unique model for reaching youth at two (2) major conferences this year (see attached). These presentations have helped to rank BEBASHI as one of the most effective AIDS education efforts in the country.

In June Children/Youth Project submitted a program for AIDS education to the Department of Human Services for the Philadelphia Youth Study Center. The program was approved and will begin in July with funds secured from A.A.C.O.

Also in June with funds from A.A.C.O. Freedom Theater has begun development of an outdoor theater production to reach out-of-school youth in Housing Projects. Freedom Theater will accompany Children/Youth Educators to workshops to youth in July and begin production in August. The play is tentatively planned to premier in September at Raymond-Rosen Housing Projects.

The City Representative Office has agreed to supply technical support and assist in coordination of logistics. The Raymond-Rosen tenant council has agreed to support BEBASHI's effort and will generate community support and enthusiasm.

The month of July will be utilized to solicit support from area radio stations and other community groups.

The Children/Youth Project Manager has been involved in helping to begin the planning stages for creation of a city-wide Black Ministers Council. This effort is an attempt to begin an education effort by the Black Church Community. It is hoped that the pastors of leading Black churches will generate the support among their membership that will result in creative service and education programs to the church community. This effort is supported by A.A.C.O.

At this stage BEBASHI will help to coordinate this effort and provide consultation in developing concepts for the Black Ministers Council.

The Children/Youth Project Manager also is a member of the Executive Planning Committee for the School District of Philadelphia proposed AIDS and Adolescents conference. This conference committee is at present trying to determine the target audience and purpose and feasibility of such a conference.

The Children/Youth Project Manager is meeting with Tabor Childrens Services Youth Services Inc., and Pennsylvania Parental Association to do expanded workshops in a series over three to six (3-6) months. These workshops will include AIDS - Drugs - STD's, Self-Esteem, Responsibilities and making choices.

Recommendations

The most important recommendation is the need for full time staff. As programs expand their focus it will take a more skilled professional to conduct workshops.

It is most important that BEBASHI be in the forefront of AIDS Education to set a standard by which others will be compared.

Without proper staff support this will be hard to accomplish.
