How come the Philadelphia AIDS Task Force has no plan of action about targetting services to blacks with AIDS--despite the fact that 57%--much more than half--of the cases of AIDS are among non-whites?

How come the Philadelphia AIDS Task Force is working on problems such as what to do about the pets of people with AIDS--but doesn't have the time to develop a strategy to combat AIDS among those who are dying from it the most?

How come the Philadelphia AIDS Task Force doesn't have a single black or non-white person working in its office out of 14 staff people--and most of the jobs were only advertised to their overwhelmingly white volunteers?

DON'T WE DIE TOO?

How come most of the clients receiving Task Force services are white (60% by their own figures), while most of the people with AIDS are non-white? And how come they don't do anything about it?

DON'T WE DIE TOO?

And how come the city and federal governments continue to use taxpayers dollars--over \$100,000 of it and lots more on the way--to fund the Task Force when it clearly doesn't know how to serve the needs of the majority of the people in need?
