If you're black and you have AIDS, you're gonna die faster from AIDS than if you're white.

And you're more likely to do it alone.

It's about caring for each other.

We need to teach each other how to stop the spread of AIDS. We need to help each other when we get AIDS, to make sure that we get the services and the treatment we need.
